**Garden Guides | Plants to Attract Hummingbirds in Florida**  
There is a bounty of hummingbird- and butterfly-attracting tropical plants from around the world that cannot be successfully grown north of USDA Zone 10 without winter protection. Even many Florida native plants of tropical origin do not range north of USDA Zone 10A and some do not occur north of Zone 10B.

February and March (Southern U.S.) Hummingbird migration begins early in the southern United States. Areas in the Deep South, including north Florida and south Georgia, can put out hummingbird feeders as soon as the middle to late February or early March and expect to be visited by the first arriving migrants.

This South Florida form is sometimes referred to as E. arborea, a name that most authorities now consider a synonym.
