Manual Handling Risks in Healthcare. Hazardous manual tasks are the largest cause of occupational injury to nurses and midwives. Musculoskeletal injuries from patient handling account for a considerable number of manual handling injuries to nurses, midwives and other healthcare workers.

Manual handling refers to the moving of items/people either by lifting, lowering, carrying, pushing or pulling. While the weight of an object handled can be a cause of injury, the frequency with which the movement is repeated, the distance which an item is carried or moved, and the height at which an object is picked up/put down from are also sources of injury.

When all full-time nurses working at the medical centre are considered, the prevalence of all manual handling injuries was 20.6% (n=108) and 15.7% (n=87) for back injuries. About two-thirds (67.6%) of all manual handling injuries were associated with direct patient care activities and another third (32.4%) with non-direct patient care activities.

The following major contributors to nurse injuries have been recorded: manual handling of people; muscular stress with no objects being handled; slips, trips and falls; manual handling of trolleys; the use and adjustment of beds; handling of linen and lead aprons. Sprains and strains were the main types of manual handling injury.

These include: care workers are not required to perform tasks that put them and their clients at risk unreasonably client's personal wishes on mobility are respected wherever possible client's independence and autonomy is supported as fully as possible.

Manual handling is the highest accident trigger reported to the Health and Safety Authority (HSA) by the healthcare sector. In 2010, 35% of the total number of incidents reported by the healthcare sector to the HSA were manual handling incidents. Reported incidents concern both patient handling and the manual handling of inanimate loads.

Forces exerted on the nurse's musculoskeletal structure during manual lifting or handling or when moving heavy, dependent, or nonparticipatory patients commonly exceed levels that the body can safely tolerate. Nurses exert themselves more for patients who: •are obese or overweight •are emotionally
