Yahweh: God - The name of God used most often in the Hebrew Bible is YHWH known as a tetragrammaton (four-letter word). Hebrew is read right-to-left so the letters Yöd , Hè , Vav and Hè are taken for consonants and expanded to Yahweh or Jehovah in English.

The name Labbeus is a Hellenized form of the Hebrew word **לבב** (levav, Strong's #3824) meaning "heart" and the Hebrew name may have been **לבבי** (levaviy) meaning "my heart" or **לבביה** (levaviyah) meaning "heart of Yah."
